

Our 2020 Spring Season marks the beginning of our centenary celebrations. Throughout the year we will be revisiting some of our favourite plays, presenting one we've performed in each decade since The Progressive Players began.

20th - 25th January

Pygmalion

We kick off our centenary season with George Bernard Shaw's classic tale of social climber Eliza Doolittle's quest to break out of poverty and speak like a lady. Following a chance meeting at Covent Garden with linguist Henry Higgins the transformation begins. Will Higgins succeed in passing off this "squashed cabbage leaf" as a duchess? Will the flower girl's dreams come true? Shaw acted as an adviser to the Progressive Players when they first started and his much loved comedy of the English manners and social class became the hit musical My Fair Lady. February 17th - 22nd

She Stoops to Conquer

Kate and Charles could be the perfect match but he's too shy to talk to a 'real' lady and prefers to flirt with barmaids down the pub. When the London bachelor visits the country Kate's barfly brother plays a trick and things get even more complicated. Determined to get her man, Kate comes up with the perfect solution. The Progressive Players first performed Oliver Goldsmith's rip-roaring comedy of manners in 1924 and it's the group's most performed play.
